Position of post-doc in the NCN OPUS 14, no. UMO-2017/25/B/ST4/02698 project entitled "Theory of relativistic and quantum electrodynamics effects for the prediction of dielectric and refractive properties of atomic gases " financed by NCN is open for application.

We are looking for motivated candidates:

- with a PhD degree in Chemistry or Physics (physical chemistry, theoretical physics), gained not later than in the moment of beginning of employment,
- high-level expertise in computer programming for scientific applications, particularly in fortran language,
- excellent knowledge of the nonrelativistic electronic structure theory, in particular methods based on the coupled cluster theory,
- excellent knowledge of the relativistic electronic structure theory of molecules,
- excellent knowledge of computational methods of the bound-state quantum electrodynamics and practical experience in applications of these methods,
- proficiency in scientific English writing.

The candidate must meet the requirements of art. 113 of the Act - Law on Higher Education dated August 28, 2018 (Journal of Laws of 2018, item 1668, as amended).

We offer: a full time position. Contract with the University of Warsaw from 15.07.2019 to 14.07.2020 with a possibility of one-year extension.
