An announcement for post-doctoral research position

Position of post-doc (*pol. adiunkt*) in the Sonata Bis 7 project entitled "Alpha-helicomimetic foldamers - synthesis, self-assembly and molecular recognition" financed by National Science Centre, Poland is open for application.

Project leader: dr Karolina Pułka-Ziach.

Available positions: 1.

We are looking for motivated candidates with:

- a PhD degree in chemistry or related field, gained not earlier than 7 years before and not later than in the moment of beginning of employment,
- good command of English,
- experience in organic synthesis (also under microwave irradiation) and spectroscopic methods, such as: NMR, UV-Vis, CD; experience in supramolecular chemistry is highly welcomed,
- teamwork skills.
- high motivation for scientific work and scientific invention.

The candidate must meet the requirements of art. 113 of the Act - Law on Higher Education and Science dated July 20, 2018 (Journal of Laws of 2018, item 1668 as amended).

We offer:

a temporary contract with the University of Warsaw (full time position, 15 months contract).
